The Kijiji Initiative is a multi-faceted program designed to empower young women in Samburu County, Kenya. This annual initiative, held in conjunction with the Kijiji Cup, aims to address critical issues such as sexual and reproductive health, gender-based violence, and period poverty.

Project Activities

- Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR)
- Gender-Based Violence (GBV) Prevention
- Period Poverty Action

Project Goals

- To empower young women with knowledge and skills to make informed decisions about their health and well-being.
- To promote gender equality and challenge harmful social norms.
- To create a safe and supportive environment for young women to express themselves and seek support.
- To address period poverty and ensure that all girls have access to menstrual hygiene products and education.





Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR)

- Conduct comprehensive SRHR education sessions, covering topics such as menstruation, contraception, HIV/AIDS, and sexually transmitted infections.
- Conduct sessions where we will talk about the harmful effects some cultural practices Mainly Female Genital Mutilation(FGM)
- Provide access to menstrual hygiene products and promote healthy menstrual hygiene practices.
- Organize counseling sessions and support groups to address concerns and provide emotional support.

Gender-Based Violence (GBV) Prevention

- Conduct self-defense training workshops to empower young women to protect themselves.
- Raise awareness about the dangers of GBV and encourage reporting of incidents.
- Provide support services to survivors of GBV, including counseling and legal aid.

Period Poverty Action

- Distribute menstrual hygiene products, such as reusable pads and sanitary pads.
- Conduct menstrual hygiene education sessions to break down stigma and promote healthy practices.
- Advocate for policies that address period poverty and ensure access to menstrual hygiene products.



PROBLEM



The Kijiji Initiative addresses the pressing challenges faced by young women in Samburu County, including:

- Harmful Traditional Practices:
 Harmful practices such as Female
 Genital Mutilation (FGM) continue to
 persist, negatively impacting the
 health and well-being of young
 women.
- Period Poverty: Many girls are unable to attend school or participate in daily activities due to lack of access to menstrual hygiene products.
- Limited Access to Sexual and Reproductive Health Information and Services: Many young women lack accurate information about their bodies, menstrual health, and sexual health.
- High Rates of Gender-Based
 Violence: Young women in Samburu
 County are disproportionately affected
 by gender-based violence, including
 sexual assault, domestic violence, and
 early marriage.



MENSTURAL HYGIENE WORKSHOP



The workshop highlighted the importance of male involvement in addressing period poverty. These young men shared insightful solutions on how to support their female peers.

FGM COMMUNITY AWARENESS WORKSHOP

A landmark event held to raise awareness about the consequences of FGM and to empower community advocacy.

The workshop featured powerful keynote speeches, interactive sessions, and practical demonstrations. To further support the attendees, the workshop concluded with the distribution of gifts including lesos, foodstuffs, sanitary pads, and monetary tokens for those who participated in the games and activities.





SENEIYA SPECIAL SCHOOL VISIT

During our visit, we registered the institution as members of The Brilliant Feminine, interacted with the girls and boys who taught the team basic sign language techniques and got to share their stories, we then donated essential sanitary pads and food supplies to support the well-being of the over 60 girls and boys at Seneiya Special School.
